- Koalas live in eucalyptus forests and woodlands in south and east Australia.
- Adult koalas can eat up to 1kg of eucalyptus leaves per day.
- Koalas sleep 18-20 hours per day.
- Gestation takes 35 days.
- There are only between 43,000-86,000 koalas left in the wild.
- 80% of the koala habitat has already disappeared.
- Koalas communicate by belching, snoring and hooting click, squeak and hum to each other.
- Baby koalas are called joeys. They are blind and furless at birth.
- Joeys spend the first 6 months of their life in their mother's pouch.
- Koalas are highly territorial.
- Joeys have 100 teeth.
- Joeys have 8 eyes.
- Joeys have 10 toes.
- Joeys have 10 claws.
